RULES AND REGULATIONS

All racing is being conducted under the Rules and Policies of the Australian Flyball Association Inc.

In the event of a division tie, placings will be determined by countback as per the AFA Rules.

Changeover time - 90 seconds. The judge will indicate when there is 30 seconds remaining.

Team captains - any **dog changes must** be made before racing commences and please ensure that dogs are circled **BEFORE** your race. At the conclusion of racing you must sign-off that all of the information on the timesheets is correct; **this includes the CRNs**. Failure to record the correct CRN will result in your team member **NOT** receiving points.

Stewarding - all teams are asked to provide stewards promptly throughout the day to ensure the smooth running of racing.

Dogs under control - dogs are NOT PERMITTED off lead anywhere within the Showgrounds, unless in the ring. This applies to all racing and non-racing dogs.

Toileting - dogs must be toileted in the designated toileting areas ONLY. Please pick up after your dogs and use the bins provided.

**** DOGS MUST NOT BE TOILETED IN FRONT OF THE SHED SHOWN ON THE MAP BELOW AS THIS AREA IS USED BY CHILDREN ****

Grounds - please keep the Events Centre and Showgrounds clean and dispose of your rubbish in the bins provided.

Alcohol - there is to be NO ALCOHOL consumed during the race meeting.

Food vans - there is a coffee, iced tea/juice/bubble tea, and variety of food and dessert vans onsite over the weekend. Please support these vendors as they are donating to Wounded Heroes Australia!

Parking - all parking within the Showgrounds are available for use, as well as along Parker Ave (nose first). See map below for details.
