AFA Approved Count Back Rules

Count back is based first on head to head RACE wins during competition (where more than two teams are tied the count back for each team shall be the total RACE wins scored against all the teams that are tied (the combined number of wins)); if two teams are still even the teams are compared on head to head heats; if two teams are still even – then fastest heat time head to head decides the winner.
