General Information

All racing will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the Australian Flyball Association.

Break Outs: The AFA Break Out rule will be applied for all breakout occurrences. Note: Breakout times for all handicap division teams is their own seed time less 1 second

Changeover Times: Teams will have 3 minutes from the end of the proceeding race to have their box and jumps set up and be ready to race. We realise there will be many team clashes, please let the judge know prior to exiting the ring.

Stewarding: All teams are requested to participate in the stewarding throughout the day to ensure the smooth running of the competition

The AFA countback rule will apply in the event of tied places at the end of the competition.

All Competitors

- Must ensure their dogs are on lead & under control at all times unless in the ring or in their crates.
- No dog is to be tied to the ring (either in or out of the ring).
- Bitches in season are not permitted on the grounds.
- Any dog that is considered unfit for racing, either by a Veterinarian or Judge, will be excused from the competition.
- All dog faeces are disposed of in the bins provided.

All **Training in the Ring** positions have been filled. If you have registered your dog for lunchtime training in the ring don't forget to bring proof of your AFA membership otherwise you won't be allowed to participate.

Team captains: Please ensure that all time sheet information is correct prior to signing off at the completion of racing.

Code of Conduct: Participants shall, at all times, be courteous and friendly. At no time should they show displeasure with a dog. Judge, exhibitor, AFA representative, sponsor, host or spectator in or out of the ring. Never conduct yourself in a manner that would bring discredit to the sport of flyball. As a participant, whether it be exhibitor, trainer, Judge, host or AFA representative, you typify the sport of flyball.

Misconduct: Misconduct shall include, but not be limited to, abusive or foul language, demonstration of dissatisfaction with a Judge's decision, inhumane treatment of a dog, demonstration of poor sportsmanship, wilful violation of the rules with intent to gain an unfair advantage or any other behaviour that would leave a spectator or exhibitor with an unfavourable opinion of the sport of flyball.

Protests: Should a protest be lodged at a competition, that protest should be lodged before the commencement of the next heat. Further protests shall be submitted in writing to the Australian Flyball Association Inc. for appropriate action.

Round Robin Handicap Racing Format Rules for the conduct of Round Robin Handicap Racing are the AFA rules for Round Robin Format with following variations:

- To accommodate handicap structure there will be no rerun for the first false start. Where the start dog from either team false starts that dog must run again as a 5th dog
- The sound system on the Signature lights is to be disconnected (or programmed to be silent) during the start sequence so that both teams receive light signals only. (If sound is not disconnected then under the handicap structure the first team only receives a sound countdown). It may be reconnected after the first team's start to signal bad crosses.
- Handicap times will be calculated for each and every race based on the difference in seed time of both teams (ie for handicap divisions only).
