COMPETITION HOSTS

TUGGERANONG DOG TRAINING CLUB

Welcome to the Fun in the Sun Competition.

COMPETITION LOCATION

The competition is at the Tuggeranong Dog Training Club Grounds, Rowland Rees Crescent, Greenway, and can be found on Google maps.

COMPETITION RACE FORMAT

There will be 29 races on the day. We will be starting at 2pm with check in at 1 pm and judge's briefing at 1.30 pm.

There are two divisions.

The club division consists of 3 teams and will race a triple round robin, 6 races each, best 3 out of 5 (up to 30 heats each).

The open division consists of 5 teams and will race a handicapped double round robin, 8 races each, 3 heats per race (24 heats each).

In the event of ties after the round robins, division placings will be decided by a count back.

All racing will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the Australian Flyball Association.

All competitors must ensure that dogs are on lead or crated when not racing and dog droppings must be disposed of in an appropriate manner.

All dogs and competitors enter at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken Tuggeranong Dog Training Club cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss caused to dogs, people or property whilst at the event.

The judge's decisions are final.

There will be a 10 minute break as shown on the running order to provide the rest times required by the AFA rules. There may also be delays due to multiple dog handlers and judges running dogs. Please advise judges early of any clashes to help with the smooth running of the competition.

This competition is being held in association with the Tuggeranong Dog Training Club open night which runs from 5pm to 8pm. Competitors should note that there will be other dogs on the grounds who are not competing. There will also be other activities occurring during the open night festivities.

CHANGE OVER TIMES

All divisions will have 90 seconds from the end of the preceding race to have their box and jumps set up and to be ready to race. The judges will indicate when there is 30 seconds remaining.

In accordance with the AFA rules the judge may forfeit a team if they are not ready on time.

WEATHER

Canberra weather is variable especially at this time of year. Competitors should be prepared for temperatures over 30C although this is not guaranteed. Please bring plenty of sun screen and equipment for keeping your dogs cool if the weather is warm.

CHECK IN

Check in, measuring and vetting is 1pm. Judges' briefing is 1.30 pm. Racing begins at 2 pm.
