COMPETITION NOTICES







-  All races will have a 90 second change over period. Teams must not enter the ring until the judge has indicated that they may do so
-  Team captains are to ensure that information on their team's time sheet is correct prior to signing off at the end of the competition
-  All racing will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the Australian Flyball Association.


GENERAL NOTICES

-  Check in time is 9.00am
-  Racing begins at 9:30am
-  All teams are expected to supply stewards throughout the competition
-  The AFA Policy 2 - Dog Behaviour Policy requires members to ensure that their dogs are under control at all times. To meet this requirement, members are to ensure that their dogs are on lead at all times within the vicinity of the competition grounds unless in crates, tethered or in the ring
-  Lunch break will be 1 hour, subject to change depending on unforeseen circumstances such as rain imminent, delay in starting or slow racing
-  Please pick up and dispose of your dog's poop.





LUNCH TIME TRAINING IN THE RING

In accordance with AFA Policy 7 - Training in the Ring Policy, AFA members wishing to conduct training in the ring at lunch time are to:

-  Enter their details in the Training in the Ring Booking Form prior to lunch time. This form is located at the timing table
-  Produce their membership cards to a competition official when registering
-  Note that there is no minimum age for dogs for lunchtime training, however dogs under 12 months of age may not be run over jumps or train on the box
-  Ensure that only dogs not entered in the competition are permitted in the ring for lunch time training
-  Identify on the form whether entire ring or just one lane is required
-  Note that each reservation is for 5 minutes only. This may be extended subject to numbers

 Ensure that the member reserving the ring is present and is responsible for management of and safety in the ring.

RACING FORMAT

-  Division 1 will be run as a double round robin giving 6 races per team in a 'best 3 of 5 heats' format.
-  Division 2 will be run as a triple round robin giving 6 races per team in a 'best 3 of 5 heats' format
-  Ties will be broken using a head to head run off between the teams with a 'best 2 of 3 heats' format
-  Both Divisions will be run using a handicap format. Rules are the AFA rules for Round Robin Format with following variations:
 - To accommodate the handicap structure there will be no rerun for the first false start. Where the start dog from either team false starts that dog must run again as a 5th dog
 - Handicap times will be calculated for each and every race based on the difference in seed time of both teams
 - Breakout Times for every team are based on their seed time minus 1 second. All teams (including Division 1) will have a Breakout time in this format.
