Features of the RSPCA Undercover Flyball Arena –

The facility is designed to cater for many types of events, but, Flyball was the main consideration from the very start.

- ceiling fans to cool the building during hotter months
- acoustic insulation installed on the walls and the roof to reduce noise
- 3 phase power and data cabling installed so that the building can be used for multiple purposes including seminars and functions
- power outlets located to suit Flyball set up
- no internal posts allowing complete flexibility for set up for racing, training and other uses
- The floor is sealed to prevent staining and for hygiene purposes
- storage for AFA matting and other equipment is accessible from 2 sides to facilitate transport of AFA matting to other venues if required
- portable PVC picket fencing with gates to define the ring area
- fully equipped kitchen for catering for race meetings and functions
- amenities under the same roof
- ramps rather than stairs for easy access
- the position of the undercover area allows for the option of either racing undercover on mats, or, on grass right next door
