Seed Times

- Teams that don't declare a seed time will use that team's fastest time from the AFA page and will be subject to the division breakout time that they are placed in, except Division 1 where breakout rule does not apply.
- When a team uses a declared seedtime, the seedtime declared by the team becomes subject to its own 1 second breakout, not the division breakout. **Note: Host club should write 'Declared' next to the seed time.**

The section of the timesheet where heats, races and times are recorded will look like the above example. It is filled out as listed below.

- Race # (enter race number from program)
- Lane: (enter left or right) for the racing lane the team is in.
- Versus: (enter who each race is against eg: 'Mock Team 2')
- Dog (circle 4 dogs): (circle the 4 dogs racing in each heat – which needs to be provided to the timekeeper prior to the start of each heat – ensure 4 dogs are circled)
- Time: times are required to be written down to .000 (a thousandth of a second, ie: 21.598). These you will get off the display on the timing Console for your lane.
- "M" is circled when a manual time is used for a heat. (Stopwatch time)
- "4" is circled by the timekeeper when only 4 dogs have completed the heat successfully. (This is important as it will mean that the team will be entitled to receive title points for that heat).
- Result: - "W" "L" "T" will be circled if the team Win (W), Lose (L) or Tie (T) a heat.
- Reason: circle if applicable i.e. DNF (Did Not Finish) / FORF (Forfeited) / INT (Interference) / CR (Crossing) / B/O (breakout)
- The next column (Any Use) is for anything that needs to be recorded ie: CRN of dog that interfered or why a team forfeited.
- The Grey column headed "Title Points" is for exclusive use of the competition secretary and will record the Title Points for each heat. (an example of a completed timesheet is in Appendix A)
- Comp Points – is for the exclusive use of the Judge to record round robin points.

Points are calculated as follows:

Teams racing in an AFA sanctioned competition will receive 1 point towards their flyball title for each dog racing in that heat when all four dogs complete the heat correctly without requiring any reruns. If that team wins the heat each dog running will receive another 1 point towards their Flyball title.

A heat that does not have the "4" circled is not entitled to any title points, except for the deviations listed below.

Heat 1 of 5: Heat completed with '4' dogs and received a 'Win' = 2 points

Heat 2 of 5: Heat not completed with 4 dogs but still received a 'Win' = 0 points

Heat 3 of 5: Heat completed with '4' dogs but 'Lost' the heat = 1 point

Heat 4 of 5: Heat not completed with 4 dogs and received a 'Loss' = 0 points

Heat 5 of 5: Team did not finish the heat so a 'Loss' recorded = 0 points

Deviations from the above rule are below:

Interference:

If a team is interfered with, the team gets one bonus title point for the win and no points for the completion. The team who caused the interference gets no title points for that heat. The team who's dog crossed the centreline gets no title points for that heat.

Crossing:

If a dog in a team 'crosses' the centreline, the race is stopped and the opposing team gets one bonus title point for the win and no points for the completion. The team who's dog crossed the centreline gets no title points for that heat.

Breakouts:

Teams that breakout in a heat will record a 'loss' for that heat even if they won the heat (for the first 3 breakouts they have in the competition) and will only be entitled to 1 title point for every breakout heat completed with four dogs (ie; the number 4 is circled). Once a team has broken out 3 times, they will not be able to record any further 'wins' in the competition even if they win a heat.

Prior to forfeiting their place in the competition and excluding other breakout heats, title points will be awarded as normal. ie: 1 title point for completion of a heat with four dogs and 1 bonus point if they win the heat with the completion of four dogs.

A team that has broken out three times in a competition can only win a maximum of one title point per heat completed with four dogs for any remaining heats run.

Once a team has broken out of the competition they will not receive any competition points and will be awarded a 'non-placing' in the competition.

Recording a Breakout

- Write the time in the time column
- Circle "B/O" indicating the breakout in the 'Reason' column next to the heat.

Under the new Breakout policy:

- First 3 heats where a breakout occurs: a team that that breaks out in a heat will get one point for a clean run (4 dogs) and record a loss.
- Subsequent heats: After the third breakout, the team has forfeited the right to place in the competition but has not forfeited the right to gain an AFA point if they complete a heat with 4 dogs.
- **The breakout team has forfeited the right to win any further heats during the competition.**

The Judge can now also easily see when a team has broken out 3 times in a competition and therefore award a 'non-placing'.

Note: Timekeepers – please let judge know when a team has a breakout & especially when a team has had 3 breakouts.

Both teams breakout in the same heat:

- Both teams get a loss.

Note: When the timesheet is calculated for a round robin racing format, the round robin points will be recorded only on the races that did not involve the team that broke out, for the entire division. A team that has already broken out in a preceding round robin format would not be eligible to race in either single or double elimination racing to decide the placings of the competition. If a team breaks out in an elimination racing format prior to the round robin format starting, they would be excused from any more elimination races, but could participate in the round robin format of the competition.

Signature Lights / Breakout Times

Note: Seed Times are set in thousands of a second but the Signature lights only recorded breakout down to hundreds of a second. It was agreed that in these circumstances the breakout time should be rounded DOWN to the nearest one hundred of a second. Example: if seed time was 21.328 then breakout time entered in the signature system would be 21.32.

Title Points & Win/Losses:

1 point – for team who broke out if they completed the heat with '4' dogs and a 'Loss' recorded (first 3 instances)

Max 1 point – for all heats where '4' dogs finish after 3 breakouts (not able to record any further wins in the competition)

A Team does not finish the heat (heat 3 below)

- When a team does not finish a heat record a 'dash' where the time would normally go and circle both 'L' and 'DNF' in the 'Reason' column (as below).

Title Points:

0 points – for the team that DNF (Did not finish)

Forfeiting a Heat (heat 3 below)

A Judge will declare the forfeit if this happens they will tell you and you are to:

- Record a 'dash' where the time would normally go and circle both 'L' and 'FORF' in the 'Reason' column (as below).
- In the Any Use column write the reason: ie; fouling in the ring, training etc

Title Points:

0 points – for the team that forfeited the heat

Recording a Tie (heat 3 below)

A tie is recorded when the time for a heat are within .003 of a second. ie: 25.598 and 26.001 are within .003 of second.

- You must notify the judge immediately.*

Title Points:

1 point – if heat completed with '4' dogs i.e. no bonus point for Win

0 points – if the heat wasn't completed with '4' dogs

Note: Team only gets '1' Competition Point for the race as the race is 'tied'. 1 heat was a win, 1 heat was a loss and the other heat was a tie so therefore the race is tied.

Card Incidents – INTERFERENCE / CROSSING & Handlers

- In the above section, the timekeepers record any cards issued to be in the format of putting a "D" in either the Yellow, Red or Black card column if the card is issued to a dog and "H" in the appropriate column if the card is issued to a handler.

Please record this information on both timesheets. (This enables easy matching of reports to incidents for the AFA)

Interference by other team (e.g. Heat 1 of 5):

- Record a 'dash' where the time would normally go for that heat and circle both 'W' and 'INT' in the 'Reason' column. Write the CRN for the dog **or** the Membership number if was the Handler in the 'Any Use' column next to the heat.
 - Note:** If the other team caused Interference then write the CRN in brackets (e.g. (100A)).
 - Note:** only 1 point is awarded if other team caused interference regardless of whether your team has finished the heat or not.

'CROSSING' by your own team (e.g. Heat 2 of 5):

- Record a 'dash' where the time would normally go for that heat and circle both 'L' and 'CR' in the 'Reason' column. Write the CRN for the dog **or** the Membership number if was the Handler in the 'Any Use' column next to the heat and mark 'D' for dog or 'H' for handler at top of timesheet for that dog or handler.

'INTERFERENCE' by your own team (e.g. Heat 3 of 5):

- Record a 'dash' where the time would normally go for that heat and circle both 'L' and 'INT' in the 'Reason' column. Write the CRN for the dog **or** the Membership number if was the Handler in the 'Any Use' column next to the heat and mark 'D' for dog or 'H' for handler at top of timesheet for that dog or handler.

Handler Cards by your own team (e.g. Heat 5 of 5):

- If this happens during a heat, record a 'dash' where the time would normally go for that heat and circle both 'L' and 'FORF' in the 'Reason' column. Write the Membership number for the Handler in the 'Any Use' column next to the heat and mark 'H' for handler at top of timesheet for that handler and the team would lose the heat.

Note: If a time was recorded and the interference happened after the race was finished, cross out the time on both timesheets and write 'INT' (this makes it clear for the competition secretary calculating the points what to do).

Title Points:

- 1 point – for team Interfered with
(teams do not get 2 points for '4' and 'Win' even if heat was finished)
- 0 points – for the team causing the interference

Calculating Competition Points (for Judges)

When the competition is completed, the Judge will need to calculate the round robin points to determine the placings for each division.

Calculating competition points:

- Where a team wins either best of 3 or best of 5 then they will receive '2' competition points for that race.
- Where a team does not gain enough wins in either best of 3 or best of 5 then they will receive '0' competition points for that race.
- Where 2 teams are tied after best of 3, or best of 5 heats then each team will receive '1' competition point.

Exceptions:

- When a team has broken out of the competition (i.e. after 3 breakouts), then that team will receive no competition points and will be awarded a 'non-placing' in the competition.
- Teams who raced against the team that broke out will receive no competition points when they raced against that team (i.e. no competition points will be awarded when races involved the team who broke out).

Combined Divisions:

- Where 2 divisions run together as a combined division then when calculating the placings for each division, only take into account the races where those teams raced each other and not when racing the other division. Eg. If division 1 & 2 combined, when working out placings for division 2 – calculate round robin points only for those races where division 2 teams raced each other and not when they raced against division 1.

Special Notes

- NO AFA Official at a sanctioned competition is allowed to write in the greyed columns. WHY? This is where the title points will be recorded by the competition organiser.
- Only the Judge is allowed to write in the Competition Points columns to determine the placings in each division.
- If there is not enough room on the timesheet for any explanation for a heat then please fill out a Judges Report form. Do not try to write the story on the timesheet.
- A judge does not have a right to award title points or take them away.

APPENDIX A

Example of completed timesheets

The attached examples are 2 teams who raced against each other in Division 2 - Mock team 1 & Mock team 2.

Notes:

- Mock team 2 broke out of the competition as they had 4 breakouts, therefore they have no placing in the competition.
- Mock team 1 won the division (although they get no competition points as they raced against a team who broke out) as they did not break out (competition points shown as example only).
- Race 25, heat 2 – example of tied rate (although in reality Mock Team 1 would win as the other team had broken out of the competition, therefore it is shown as an example only)

Reminders for Timekeepers

Things to check on timesheets:

- Check '4' is circled if 4 dogs completed the heat without any reruns.
- Ensure 4 dogs are circled for all heats (check with team captain prior to the start of the heat if not circled).
- Ensure interference/crossing incidents are marked with '---' where the time should go and write the CRN of the dog who interfered in the 'Any Use' column (put CRN in brackets if it was the dog on the other lane). Also ensure the 'D' or 'H' is marked on the top of the timesheets for the dog or handler who received the card.
- Ensure race numbers are written on the timesheet for each race (presumably competition secretary has done this, but there have been cases where timesheets are submitted to AFA with no race numbers next to each race and it makes it hard to cross check).

Checklist for Team Captains signing off Timesheets

Team captains are required to sign off timesheets at the end of a competition to check for its completeness and correctness.

Things to check on timesheets:

- Check each dog's CRN is correct (cannot be changed after the competition)
- Check 4 dogs are circled for ALL heats contested (in Column marked 'Dog')
- Check if '4' is circled if the time indicates '4' dogs completed a clean run according to the seed time. NOTE: timekeepers sometimes forget to circle the '4' when rushed, so check before signing off the timesheet. It is too late to question later (common mistake not picked up on timesheets).

Tip: If you keep team statistics, it may be worth cross checking these with timesheet – but do so in a timely manner!

Checklist for Host Club in Points Workbook

Complete Timesheets

- Clearly write down points calculated in greyed out column on timesheet for all heats
- Calculate total points for each dog and write at the top of the timesheet in the 'Total Points' column next to the each dog's name (on the right hand side of form).

Points Workbook

- Double check all CRNs for each dog
- Double check all dogs marked for each heat on the timesheet corresponds to the spreadsheet
- Double check points entered in spreadsheet against timesheet
